## Treasury Report July 2020-June 2021

I have been the treasurer for the Adelaide Hills Farmers Markets for 12 months since the last AGM and a Committee Member for 6 years. Over this time the Market has had many changes with 5 Market Managers and many changes along the way. Each Market Manager has contributed to making us a great market and over the last 2 years we had the extra bonus of experiencing some financial gain which we were able to manage in these uncertain times.

It shows that through these times of a global pandemic and the uncertainty that it has brought with it, the simplicity and honesty that comes from a local market is what we all need.

Compared to 2019 we have nearly doubled our membership, increased our regular stall holders by 30% and artisans have increased slightly too.

This year we received a grant of \$2000 from the Mount Barker Council.

We were able to pay a regular contractor to set up and pack away the market each week, Rosie Coleman for most of the time with now Maddie and Lyden sharing the role.

Rosie was also able to support Nikala Sim and later Kara Jane with some office administration and filing.

Wages, and costs associated has increased, as has the time needed to run the market as it grows and changes in its complexity.

With an overall profit of \$27,000 at June 30 and the last 3 months looking the same the Market looks set up to be able to continue to give back to the market community.
